

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS

### **BETWEEN HALDIA LAW COLLEGE AND DEPARTMENT OF MBA, HALDIA INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY**

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to establish an affiliation between Haldia Law College, Haldia (HLC) and Department of MBA, Haldia Institute of Technology (MBA HIT) for the purpose of student exchange.

This MOU pertains to exchange of five students of 5Yrs B.A. LL.B. (Hon.) 10<sup>th</sup> Semester and 3Yrs LL.B. 6<sup>th</sup> Semester from Haldia Law College visiting the MBA HIT and for equivalent numbers of students from MBA HIT visiting HLC for the purpose of summer exchange of 2 weeks.

The aforesaid colleges are hereinafter referred to individually as institution and collectively as institutions.

#### **TERMS OF THE MOU**

1. The two institutions agree to enter into MOU pertaining to exchange of students, the first of which will commence in May 2018.
2. The participating students will visit the host institutions for 2 weeks in the summer term (May, 2018).
3. Each institution may send up to five students per academic year to participate in the exchange. The number of participants may be increased subject to the mutual agreement of both the institutions.
4. The candidates will be students who have good academic standing in their academic programme at their respective institutions.
5. The candidates will be selected by their respective institution to participate in the exchange.
6. Each institution will appoint an individual faculty member to act as a coordinator for the exchange programme.
7. The sending institution will forward profiles of its candidates selected for the exchange programme beforehand.
8. The host institution will notify the sending institution and successful candidates of their provisional acceptance by February end, to enable selected students time to make appropriate arrangements. Final acceptance is subject to confirmation of continuing satisfactory academic performance in the term or semester preceding the exchange. The host institution will have the right of refusal of any candidate who may appear to be unacceptable for the exchange.
9. On arrival at the host institution, the participants of the exchange will not be required to pay any fee or incidental charges.


10. At the end of the term, the participant in exchange will request the host institution to send to the home institution a report of official transcript documenting their academic achievement.
11. The institutions will review the terms of MOU annually to assess the success of the exchange, and will determine whether to continue, modify or discontinue the MOU. Each institution reserves the right to terminate this MOU upon one month written notice to the other.
12. This MOU shall take effect when signed by both institutions, and will remain in effect for a period of five years.
13. Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or in relation to this MOU, including the validity, invalidity, breach or termination thereof, shall be settled by both institutions amicably by a mutual agreement between the two representatives of the institutions. Conflicts that cannot be resolved amicably shall be settled by arbitration.

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS

### **BETWEEN HALDIA LAW COLLEGE AND HALDIA INSTITUTE OF MANAGEMENT**

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to establish an affiliation between Haldia Law College, Haldia (HLC) and Haldia Institute of Management (HIM) for the purpose of student exchange.

This MOU pertains to exchange of five students of 5Yrs B.A. LL.B. (Hon.) 10<sup>th</sup> Semester and 3Yrs LL.B. 6<sup>th</sup> Semester from Haldia Law College visiting the HIM and for equivalent numbers of students from HIM visiting HLC for the purpose of summer exchange of 2 weeks.

### **TERMS OF THE MOU**


1. The two institutions agree to enter into MOU pertaining to exchange of students, the first of which will commence in June, 2018.

12. This MOU shall take effect when signed by both institutions, and will remain in effect for a period of five years.
13. Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or in relation to this MOU, including the validity, invalidity, breach or termination thereof, shall be settled by both institutions amicably by a mutual agreement between the two representatives of the institutions. Conflicts that cannot be resolved amicably shall be settled by arbitration.
