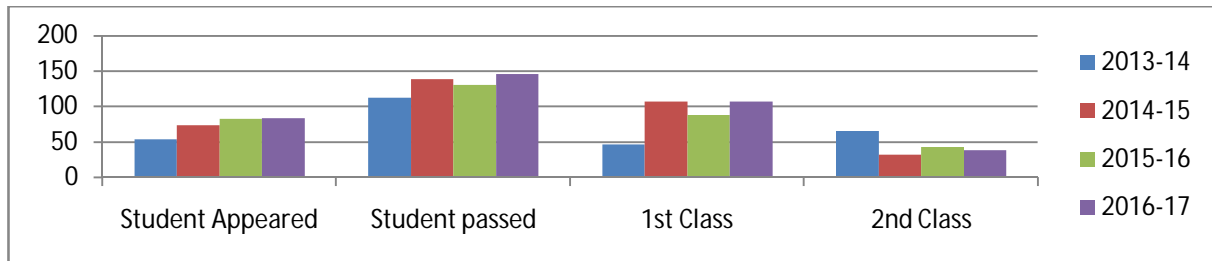


Chart 1 – Students Assessment Report of last four Academic Years

The assessment appraisal of the students depicts the fact that most of the students in the college are sincere, hardworking and have achieved good marks in their respective Examinations.

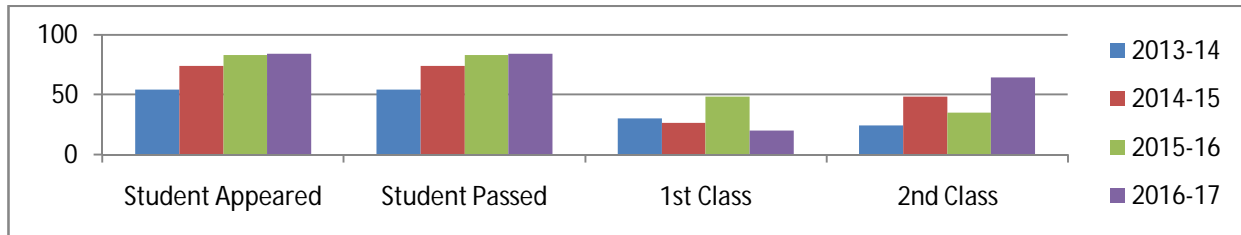


Chart 2 – Students Assessment Report of last four Academic Years
