Solving the critical environmental problems of global warming, water scarcity, pollution, bio-diversity loss are perhaps the greatest challenges of the Twenty First Century. Increase in the extinction of many plants, animal species and shifts in patterns of agriculture and rising sea level, cyclones, currents in the sea are the major alarming situations. Global warming is the result of the increasing magnitude of the so-called greenhouse effect, warming of the earth's surface and lower atmosphere caused by the presence of water vapour, carbon dioxide, methane, nitrous oxides and other greenhouse gases. The sea level rise causes coastal areas to flood due to the warm temperatures that melt glaciers. In spite of the steps taken by IPCC (International Panel on Climate Change), Kyoto Protocol and Paris Agreement, the ecosystem and biology are severely affected.

## Object

The seminar discussion will be aimed at analyzing the various causes of global warming and how the ecosystem is affected by human activities and the reasons for climate change and bio-diversity, and to create international awareness to combat global warming, imbalance of ecology and bio-diversity.
